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## I. Majors with Required Concentration:

Students must select a concentration (sometimes called a “Specialization” or “Track”) in each of the majors listed below. The concentration selected determines in part which courses are required for completion of the major.

The concentration may be selected at the time a major is declared or at a later time, but should be selected no later than the term in which junior standing is achieved (60 or more credit hours earned).
